**Under this agreement for 2017
Millchester State School will receive**

\$108,000*

This funding will be used to

- Improve English results from 87% (2016) of students achieving a 'C' or higher to 90% (2017) of students achieving a 'C' or higher.
- Increase students achieving reading targets according to the North Queensland Reading Targets from 88% (2016) to 90% (2017).
- Maintain 100% of students in Year 3 achieving at or above the National Minimum Standard for NAPLAN in reading.
- Implement Learning Walls for English in all classes.
- Conduct Case Management Meetings twice per term with the Principal, SWD/STLaN Teacher and Curriculum Co-ordinator present to have input in Tier 2 support.
- Allow the Principal to support Teachers in Teaching with a Literacy Focus for English through the Instructional Coaching Cycle (co-plan, co-teach, co-reflect and assess needs).

Our initiatives include


- Release Teachers to participate in Case Management Meetings twice per term and Planning Meetings 6 times per year.
- Employ relief staff to support Principal and Curriculum Co-ordinator to co-plan, co-teach, co-reflect and provide feedback to teachers when implementing Learning Walls, Quality Teaching and Learning, Teaching with a Literacy Focus and utilising the Three Cuing System within the curriculum.
- Employ extra Administrative and Teacher Aide hours to allow the Principal time to be the Instructional Leader within the school.
- Establish Principal as the Instructional Leader of the school through participation in Coaching Professional Development.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

Engage relief staff to support Principal and Curriculum Co-ordinator in the Instructional Coaching Cycle and giving feedback to teachers.	\$ 18 000
Engage extra Administrative and Teacher Aide hours to allow Principal to be the Instructional Leader.	\$60 000
Provide TRS to enable triads of teachers/leaders to engage in Case Management Meetings and co-planning with Principal.	\$25 000
The Principal participating in Coaching Professional Development	\$5 000
